

Home Delivery Service

Are you home-bound and unable to come to the Library on your own? The Pinckney Community Public Library offers a **Home Delivery Service** for people who are home-bound.

If you live within the Village of Pinckney/Putnam Township or the Library's service area and are seriously ill, temporarily or permanently unable to visit the Library due to physical disability or incapacitation, this program is for you! Library staff and volunteers will assist with delivering and picking up library books, audiobooks, movies or other materials you request. Anyone qualifying for **Home Delivery Service**, whether their materials are obtained in person or through **Home Delivery**, qualifies for an extended check out period of 30 days. (**Note:** The 30 days check out period does not apply to General or Children's Movies.) You can call the Library or go to the Library's website to request for your materials.

There is no charge for this service, however, past due and damage fees still apply to all materials checked out through the **Home Delivery Service**.
