SPECIAL SERVICES POLICY

OBJECTIVE:

No qualified individual with a disability shall, by reason of such disability, be excluded from participation in, or be denied the benefits of, the services, programs, materials the Library, or be subjected to discrimination by the Library.

AFFECTED DISABLED

Patrons of the Library may be disabled in the following ways:

- 1. Visually impaired
- 2. Audibly impaired
- 3. Mobility impaired
- 4. Manually impaired
- 5. Mentally impaired
- 6. Verbally impaired

PROGRAMMING

A program is planned interaction between the Library staff and the public. To serve in the task of promoting the Pinckney Community Public Library, Library materials, and services as well as offering the community an informal, entertaining or cultural experience. Programming should be an extension of the information found in the Library's collection.

The content of the programming is to be non-commercial in nature. While business or professional persons may be asked to speak at a program, their information should be generic in nature.

The time and conditions of programming are to follow the policy set out for meetings at the Library.

The Library does not endorse the statement or philosophies expressed in any program.
