How it works for Early Literacy Birth—4 years

- Pick up reading logs at the library on or after Monday June 17, or print them from our website. Or register and track reading online at: <http://wandooreader.com/pinckneylibrary/2019-summer-reading-ages-0-4>
- When you have completed 2 hours of reading bring your reading log in for a special sticker. After reading 8 hours (4 stickers) you will get a rubber ducky or board book to keep!
- Complete an Early Literacy Activity Log for an additional prize.
- Attend fun library events throughout the summer!

How it works for Children ages 5-12

- Pick up reading logs at the library on or after Monday June 17, or print them from our website. Or register and track reading online at <http://wandooreader.com/pinckneylibrary/2019-summer-reading-ages-5-12>
- When you come into the library pick up your necklace (one per patron) and first brag tag. If you still have your necklace from a previous summer bring it in and we will give you a special brag tag for reusing it!
- Once you have completed 2 hours of reading check in at the library for a star bead for your necklace. Once you have read 4 hours you will get a fun rocket brag tag to add to your necklace. Keep reading to add to your necklace.
- Complete the Lost in Space Scavenger Hunt for an additional prize.
- Attend fun library events for additional beads for your necklace.

Read to Therapy Dogs Josephine & Ruby

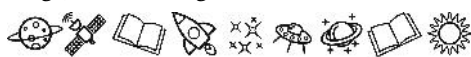
