How do we join the fun?



Register to read online or using the ReadSquared app. ReadSquared will help you track reading and rewards! Get notifications when your child wins a prize. Registration is free. You can register an individual or your family. Go online at <http://pinckneylibrary.readsquared.com/> or get the app to register your readers.

- If you would like a paper reading log please visit the library.
- **Babies birth to 4 :** Read to your baby 100 minutes to get a sticker. For every 500 minutes you read get a prize. After 1000 minutes pick a book to keep!
- **Kids 5–12 years :** Register to read and get a necklace and special bead. For every 100 minutes you read check in at the circulation desk for a new bead for your necklace! After 500 minutes of reading you get a special prize. Read 1000 minutes to complete the program and get a special bead!
- **Teens 13-17 years :** For every 500 minutes of reading you get a pick off of the prize cart!
- Attend fun library events throughout the summer! Events will be in-person in the library program room unless otherwise noted. Additional registration is required for some programs.
